Treasurer's report

In 2022 the in-year deficit was a result of little income and extra costs associated with repositioning the charity through website development, new banners and information leaflets, as well as the new offering from Togetherall. The trustees took the decision to sign a multi-year deal with Togetherall to fill an identified gap in our ability to offer psychological support for mental wellbeing to all operational team members of both mounain and cave rescue.

Overall the charity has received more income than cost and as such the trustees were content that the extra cost of the Togetherall offering would not have a detrimental effect going forward.

An outstanding 2020 hardship payment of £1,000 was repaid in full.

The fund received more direct applications for physical rehabilitation support this year, with The Fire Fighters Charity facility at Penrith again utilised. Claims also involved younger applicants, bringing the average age of all claimants up to 50. It should be noted that due to the anonymity of those supported by Togetherall, the breakdown of cost by support type by gender is not provided.

The Trustees ensure there is adequate Trustees Indemnity Insurance cover provided and review the policy at the annual renewal. This cost can be identified as governance costs in the accounts.

The new website and the attendance at the MREW Conference in September 2022 saw a good deal of interest generated with a number of pledges made to support the charity in 2023.
